We ended with a brief discussion on next month's agenda, and the agenda for the DDU later that evening. We also looked at when the next DDU/Gathering should be held. It was decided that we would do that in January to provide a make-up date for those who could not attend the November DDU and still allow them to attend in time to team or sponsor on the spring walks.

As of the October Board meeting, Lola McDonald will be responsible for arranging music for the Gatherings and Walk Closings, unless the Walk Music Director takes care of Closing music.

Steve Makely will be responsible for delivering and setting up, "with assistance", the Community sound equipment for Gatherings and Walks.
