#### Board News...

The Board of directors met at Hillcrest UMC just prior to the gathering on May 12, 2007. There was a quorum present.

The board acted on the 4<sup>th</sup> day ministry's most recent recommendation to the team selection committee. The board passed a motion that set forth a guideline for the Team selection committee and the team cadre to work together cooperatively to make team assignments.

We accepted a resignation from Terry Cook, who sighted personal issues as a need to terminate her service on the board. It is with deep regret and understanding that we accept this resignation.

At this point there was discussion and election of the Community Lay Director and Assistant Community Lay Director for 2007-2008. Ralph Williams was elected by ballot to be the next Assistant Community Lay Director and Mark Lawrence was not opposed to serve as Community Lay Director for a second term. Jim Muhlenkamp was selected as Community Spiritual Director 2007-2008.

There were brief reports from the team critiques of E-66 and E-67. One of the things that was discussed was the hazards of having candle light at the Pavilion. Several people have voiced concern and even reports of tripping while crossing the bridge and the ditch. It was decided that we would encourage future Weekend leadership to steer away from the use of the pavilion for night time activities. We don't want anyone to get injured or have an insurance claim against the community.

#### **Community Focus:**

Training for the Emmaus Community Lay members from the Upper Room Regional Representative will be scheduled for October 13<sup>th</sup>. Mark Lawrence read a letter concerning the beginning of Emmaus Communities in several African countries. He will announce at the Gatherings that if desired, our members can make donations during Gatherings to aid in this endeavor.

Meeting was adjourned about 5:30 PM.

#### From the Team Selection Committee ...

The Greater Fredericksburg Emmaus Team Selection Committee had their first monthly meeting under the new guidelines on Friday May 11, 2007.

This was primarily an organizational meeting. I feel that it was very productive and encouraging. The committee respectfully asks that we change the way we apply to team. Instead of submitting an application for each walk, they ask that we submit an application now or as soon as you feel you are ready, if you want to be considered for a team anytime in the next two years. The idea being that we would have a larger pool of people to pull from that are interested in teaming. If you are contacted and you can't do it this time you may decline and we move on to the next application and you may be considered again for the next team. You also would then be responsible for updating that application in the event that you move, change your phone number or other personal contact information.

People will be contacted based on guidelines from the Upper room Emmaus manual and handbook. First, there will be a lot of prayer. Second, a team should be composed by thirds: one-third from new team members, one-third with moderate experience and one-third with considerable experience.

As this is an ecumenical community, we will try to get a representative mix of denominations. We would also look at certain talents like musicians and take into account the wishes of the Weekend Lay Director and the Lead Walk Spiritual Director.

One of the things that we saw in the manual was a progression of servant hood. The national model suggests that a new team member should be someone who is active in the community, has attended a Day of Deeper Understanding and several gatherings. Also, that they participate in other activities to show support of the community, such as attending a candle light service and providing agape to pilgrims. New team members should also take advantage of an early opportunity to work as a community cha or provide some other background support of a walk before their being on their first team. These are not rules set in concrete, but suggested quidelines.

A similar progression was seen concerning leadership in teams. Service first in the talk room and then background service, then Assistant Lay director, and finally considered for Weekend Lay Director. Spiritual Directors and Musicians should also have experience as a table leader or assistant table leader before progressing on to their respective positions.

### From Greg Engroff our Upper Room Regional Representative

While we were in Nashville at the Advisory Committee meeting, we heard from the people of Africa; South Africa to be exact and part of the report was about the new communities trying to form in Ghana and Zimbabwe. The problem is that inflation is running wild and there aren't enough funds to start; they're really just no funds. Now there were about 30 people in the room at the time and one of them asked how much they need to get started. While they needed a lot, she said that to get it going they'd need about \$5000 now but more later. So we passed the hat, literally, and discovered that we raised, right there, \$4750. While we thought that was pretty cool, someone pointed out that she asked for \$5000 so we passed the hat again and ended up with \$5090. Here's the thing, they need more; money is the only thing stopping them. So the 5 Regional Reps. agreed that we could each raise \$5000 in our region for a total of \$25,000 (plus the \$5000 that we already raised). So I'm asking you, please get this message out to your Community. All dollars will go to these 2 countries!

IRS Changes for 2007

Starting in January, to claim a deduction on your itemized tax return, the IRS is making it complicated. Taxpayers will need to provide backup in order to claim a deduction on their tax return; no more "lists" will be accepted. The taxpayer must provide a canceled check(s), bank record or a receipt from the charity listing the organization's name, the date of the donation and the amount. Beginning January 2007, we began tracking and recording all checks received as donations to the General and Scholarship funds. Please consult with your accountant or tax preparer on the deductibility of your Team and Sponsorship fees for charitable contributions. Monthly letters or annual statements will be mailed regardless of the donation amount.

If you would like credit for your cash donations made at Gatherings, Candlelight, Sponsors Hour, and Closings, please place the cash in an envelope marked with your name, address and amount.
