"Do You Love Me...Tend My Sheep."

Just a thought from the Community Spiritual Director

At a recent team meeting the question of the night was, "If you were able to be face to face with Jesus and able to ask Him a question, what would the question be?" That was a very simple but impacting question. Something else happened though, at least for me. Throughout the following week I kept coming back to that team question. If I asked Jesus a question, it would only be fair for Jesus to ask one back. This is what I heard Him ask me, "Do you love me?"

Why would Jesus ask me that? Doesn't He realize how I am serving Him these days? My time and gifts are used for Him. "Yes Lord I love you."

Then I asked myself by what measuring stick I was measuring my love for my Savior. It hit me that our time and gifts are things we need to strive in using, things we need to do better at using and things we need to use more often; but, these things alone are not a measure of the love I have for my Lord.

There is a story about a granddaughter who says; "Grandpa, I love you very much" He was smiling, and asked, "How much do you love me?" She stretched her hands out as far as they could and said, "That much." He smiled and told her that he loved her too. And then she added, "I love you even more than that (as she was stretching her arms out again), but my arms are not long enough."

Isn't love an amazing thing? Love is something that really cannot be bought. So how do we measure if we really love Jesus? Remember in John 21:15-17, Jesus tells Peter "Tend my sheep." I believe if we will really try to understand what Jesus meant, we will be able to measure at least a portion of our love for Christ. So how do we do what Jesus said to do, "Tend my sheep?"

In Matthew 22:37-39 (NIV) the Bible reads, "Jesus replied, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. <u>And the second is like</u> <u>it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'</u> When you and I change our thoughts from seeking what we need, and put others first, we "Tend His Sheep."

I see Emmaus as a way for all of us to "Tend His Sheep." We know through personal experiences the importance of Emmaus. We know that people can experience Jesus in ways that they haven't before. We don't have too much difficulty in the forming of teams, praise the Lord, but I do have a concern when it comes to sponsoring. What do I mean? Sponsoring is something that has been looked at as, "I pray for God to show me who I should approach, I get them to walk, I see them through to closing and my sponsoring is complete". As we all know sponsoring does begin with the prayer for God showing you, giving you the one to sponsor. What I believe we miss is the fact that sponsoring never ends. It is very much like discipleship. So how do we "Tend His Sheep" in Emmaus? We sponsor of course, but then we stay in touch, we send cards of encouragement, we call, we visit, we find ourselves living in Acts 2:42 (NIV)... "They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer." We see each other, love on each other, and fellowship with each other <u>at the monthly gatherings</u>. Sponsoring begins with the prayer, but it never ends... "Tend His Sheep." If Jesus asked you "Do You Love Me." How would you answer?

Please pray with me... "Lord, I would ask you now to keep us mindful of our complete dependence on You. Help us to stay mindful of how each of us can tend your sheep. May we be mindful at the entrance to our heart and minds our ability to so easily sin. Lord, when we do, help us to know that You already knew it was going to happen. You love us, even knowing our flaws, and You are always ready to restore us to fellowship. Thank you for that wonderful grace and mercy. Amen."

Directions to Camp Happyland:

21457 Happyland Drive Richardsville, VA 22736

From Central Park in Fburg: Drive 7.5 miles west on Route 3. Turn right (North) on Route 610, Elys Ford Road. Drive 9 miles north on Route 610. Just prior to the green Richardsville sign, turn right (East) on Route 619, Richards Ferry Road. Drive 1.3 miles to Happyland Drive. You will see a large Camp Happyland sign on the right side of the road. Turn right into the Camp and proceed to the parking area. Total distance from Central Park is about 18 miles.
