<u>From I-95:</u> Take exit 130B, heading west on Rt 3. Go one light past the Spotsy Towne Ctr and turn right onto Bragg Road. Continue on Bragg Road, (which turns into Fall Hill Ave), for approx 2 miles, (past Central Park), and turn left onto Bragg Hill Dr. The Family Life Center is on the left.
