From the Community Spiritual Director...

Hello all...

What an exciting time to be serving our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ! I wanted to take a moment to update you on the current clergy processes we are striving to come into compliance with. As a reminder the Upper Room sets forth this process. The following is an excerpt from the 2009 letters that we (your board) have to sign. You may find for review the letter of agreement that we sign each year at FredWalk.org.

"We would like to take this opportunity to update you on the "Clergy Certification Process." At the October meeting of Regional Lay and Clergy Leaders, the five clergy leaders, along with myself, formalized a plan for this process. It is our hope that this plan will enable a smooth transition to having all clergy qualified. The approved plan is as follows:

- 1. All applications for certification must be in the hands of the appropriate Clergy Regional Leader <u>no later than December 31, 2009</u>. If you have questions regarding whether or not persons may or not already be qualified, please contact the same Clergy Regional Leader. Be reminded that only those clergy faithfully serving the Emmaus and Chrysalis movement <u>prior to December 31, 2007</u> are eligible for the certification process.
- 2. Between now and December 31, 2010, The Upper Room will be conducting Clergy Leadership Development Sessions throughout the five regions in the United States. Each person desiring certification will have the opportunity to so do, and, at a location near them.
- 3. The Clergy Certification Process and the Clergy Criteria documents are on The Upper Room website: <u>www.upperroom.org</u>. Click on "Walk to Emmaus" under "Programs."

The purpose of this certification process is to expand the number of clergy available for weekends and for service in the Emmaus and Chrysalis movement."

To the clergy who have sent in their Clergy Application, I thank you. To those who still have that application on their desk, please proceed with haste sending them to the Fredericksburg Emmaus PO box. If you have any questions regarding this process please feel free to contact me at your convenience.
