Sponsors from our 2010 Fredericksburg Emmaus Walks (FE-78/79/80/81):

4th Day Follow-Up training for your Pilgrim will be on January 8, 2011, at 1st Christian Church at 9AM. This training is mandatory in order for them to Sponsor and Team. If YOU bring your Pilgrim to this important event it will be transformational – your Pilgrim will engage, participate and help the Community conduct our Father's business through Emmaus. If you do not bring your Pilgrim, chances are we will not see them again.

December 2010 Board Actions:

- (1) The Board approved the agenda and initiation of Men's and Women's Team Orientation meetings in January and February 2011 respectively. The Orientation meetings will be hosted by Dawn Kendall and SD Tom Britt, be considered the first Team meeting, and be where initial teaming instructions and assignments will occur, pursuant to our Emmaus Upper Room Guidelines.

- (4) The Board concurred on a recommendation by Ken Roark that the Community NOT have an official Board sanctioned Facebook presence on the Internet.
- (5) The Board concurred on a motion by Ken Roark that the Weekend Music Teams play at Gatherings for the month their Team is Commissioned and that the Weekend Music Teams for Men and Women both play on the month following the Spring and Fall Walks.

Happy New Year 2011 Fredericksburg Emmaus Community!

From the desk of the Community Spiritual Director

Welcome Two Thousand and Eleven! Blessed New Year greetings to our Fredericksburg Emmaus community. This will be a year of "transition" as we continue to come into compliance with The Upper Room model and abide by the Letter of Agreement. While reading The Upper Room Handbook on Emmaus, Stephen Bryant shares this thought on keeping faith with the Manuals – "The manuals prevent Emmaus from being remade after the likeness of the various leaders. Unlike many religious events, Emmaus is not leader-centered; it does not depend on charismatic personalities, especially gifted presenters or experienced retreat masters. Rather, Emmaus depends on a team of ordinary Christians working together in the spirit of Christ according to the directions of an objective manual for a proven model. The Lay and Spiritual Directors for each Walk are responsible to the local Emmaus board of Directors, and the local board is in covenant with the Upper Room to lead Emmaus according to the manual."

In biblical language, people "cut" a covenant with another person or group of people. As an example, Abraham and Abimelech cut such a covenant as equal partners, agreeing that the well at Beersheba belonged to Abraham (Gen. 21:22-24). Each covenant had special conditions affecting the power in authority and the one who became a vassal. The covenant also imposed demands on each partner of this covenant between equals. Breaking covenant conditions meant treason and extreme punishment. Our Lay and Spiritual Directors are responsible to, in our case, and are in covenant with the Fredericksburg Emmaus Board of Directors. Likewise, your Board of Directors is in covenant, (a pact, treaty, alliance, or agreement between two parties of equal or of unequal authority), with The Upper Room.

As your Community Spiritual Director, I am in full agreement with the intent to fully comply with established Letter of Agreement entered into by the Fredericksburg Emmaus Board of Directors and The Upper Room as it pertains to leading Emmaus according to the manual. I would recommend that each of us search our hearts with the understanding that our "integrity" must be protected, especially when applied to the Letter of Agreement with The Upper Room. Our "yes" must be in effect....YES! The integrity of our community is at stake. Does this mean that we have no areas in which to disagree? No! There are areas that are inherent to our community which are not supported by The Upper Room. These areas are rare instances and we are encouraged to make those known to The Upper Room so that productive and concrete dialog can take place. Let me be completely honest here, there are some spiritual concerns that will affect our community and these concerns are being addressed directly to the Regional Clergy Leader.

What I am asking of you is your continued patience and prayers as we work towards compliance. The Board of Directors are aware of the plethora of opinions and outright hostility exerted towards certain Board members. This should not be! We are commanded to show love where disagreement exists. What we don't want is dissension among the brotherhood or bitterness to develop (Prov. 6:19; Heb. 12:15). I implore you to wait for official notification from your Board of Directors. God will see us through this transitional change – quick to listen and slow to speak.
