#### WELCOME AUTUMN!

To everything there is a season, and a time for every purpose under heaven. Ecclesiastes 3:1

These words of the teacher of Ecclesiastes remind me that another season is upon us. Autumn is my most favorite season of the year! Some of my family and friends can't understand my love of this season. They consider autumn a sad time for they say that nature is dying with the leaves changing colors and then turning brown and then falling from the trees. I don't see autumn that way.

I see the beauty of the white clouds against a brilliant blue sky. I feel the crispness of the cooler air and love the freshness that it brings. I love the beautiful mums and pumpkins decorating people's yards. I love going to the pumpkin patch with the children of our church and choosing a pumpkin, getting some gourds and apples, having a hayride, and walking in the hay maze. I love to see the brilliance of the sunrise and sunset in the autumn sky. I love to think of bonfires and roasting marshmallows and sitting by the fire as the air gets cooler--things I rarely do in the heat of the summer.
