Greetings and peace to you all,

As summer ends and many things begin again, like school, football, and school activities, it is easy to let out worldly schedule squeeze our spiritual schedule very thin. We can be so much more as a community of faith if we pull together, heal hurts and meet needs together, and continue to grow in Christian discipleship together.

My Scriptural basis for this need to be in community and hold each other comes from Hebrews 10:23-25a "Let us hold fast to the confession of our hope without wavering, for he who has promised is faithful. And let us consider how to provoke one another to love and good deeds, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one another".

Let us gather together as the Children of God to do the work of the Risen Lord!
