WHY SERVE ON AN EMMAUS TEAM?

My name is Ron Jennings. On Sundays, I worship at Fairview Baptist Church. I walked on FE#66 and sat at the Table of John. After I had time to digest the Walk to Emmaus a little, I saw how organized the Weekend was and thought it might be fun to be part of the team, helping make another such Walk happen for other lucky pilgrims.

So I served and learned that it is as much fun or more to serve as it is to walk as a pilgrim. It's not always easy. Much time goes into Weekend preparations and a team member must be dedicated, diligent and willing serve in whatever capacity s/he is asked to serve. No one is too good to do any part; no one is too lowly to do any part, either.

After my walk, my sponsor made sure I attended the 4th Day Training, though it did not occur to me till later that I needed to fill out a teaming application in order to be considered to be asked to serve as a team member! Not everyone who fills out an application will be asked to serve; persons might be called right away or after a long while.
