### **“Volunteer or Minister”**

“Each of you should use whatever gift you have received to serve others, as faithful stewards of God’s grace in its various forms.” 1 Peter 4:10

At the July Board meeting, we discussed Community Volunteer positions. If you look in the back of the Newsletter each month, in addition to the 15 members of the Board, you’ll see 26 other volunteer positions, some filled, some not. The Board hasn’t really reviewed them in quite some time and we feel the time to do so is now. So in the next month or two, we plan on looking closely at what needs to be done in the Community and making any adjustments to this list of positions as may be warranted.

Our approach will likely be to have members of the Board responsible for broad categories of support and invite Community members to participate within those categories. This might look something like a Board member as a Communication Coordinator with Community support for the website/Facebook/Instagram, the Newsletter, and the database administrator.

A few years back, an associate Pastor of my church refused to use the word volunteer when talking about positions in the church. Her point was that we are all gifted by God and as disciples,

it is our calling to use those gifts to His glory. We may be invited to serve but we do so not as volunteers but as ministers, active members of the Body of Christ. I’ve seen this described such that volunteers give what they can out of their leftovers, but ministers give their best, their first fruits, to God’s plan.

Think back to your Walk. There were about 30 members of the team that you saw and interacted with. However, The Upper Room® estimates that there are likely 95 or more people involved in putting an Emmaus Walk together when you consider the Team, the prayer chains, Pilgrim and Team registrars, Board, and a myriad of other duties.

The message here is that we need you. We need active members of the Body of Christ. So if you are invited to serve in some way, please prayerfully consider saying yes. The tasks will not be overly burdensome, moreover, you will be blessed in this service.

As we as a community prepare for FE 107 and FE 108, may we remember Paul’s words. May we share in the one Spirit; may we be of the same mind and have the same love; may we be humble and look to the interests of others. May our fourth day witness be one of love and unity with one another in Christ.

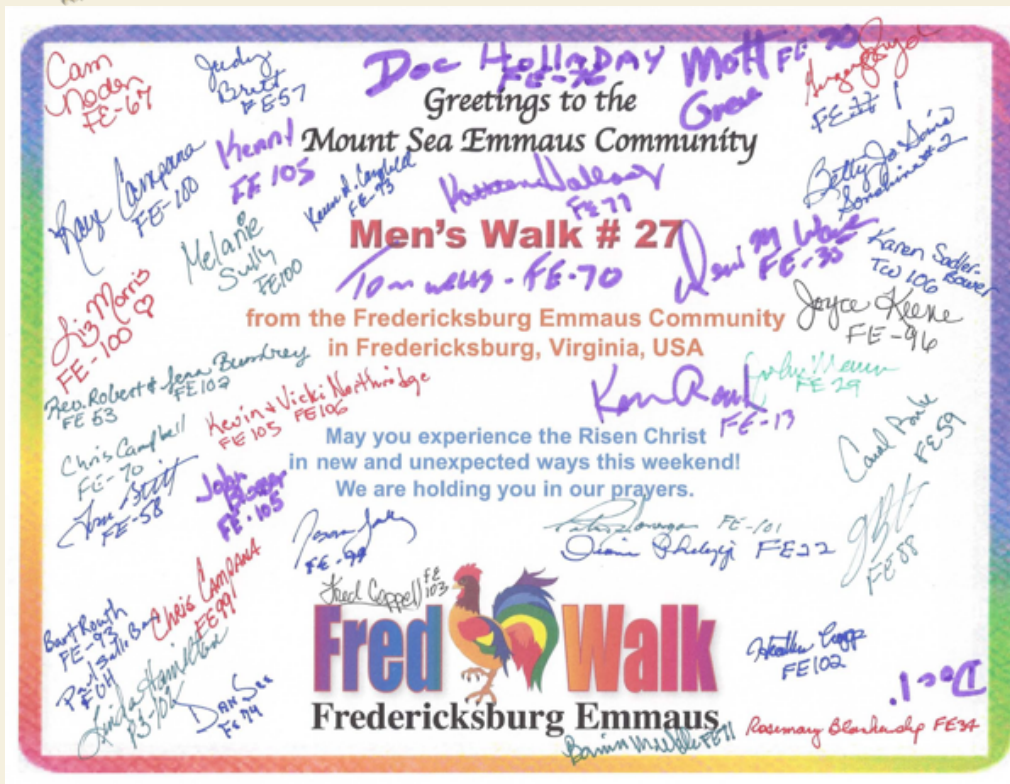

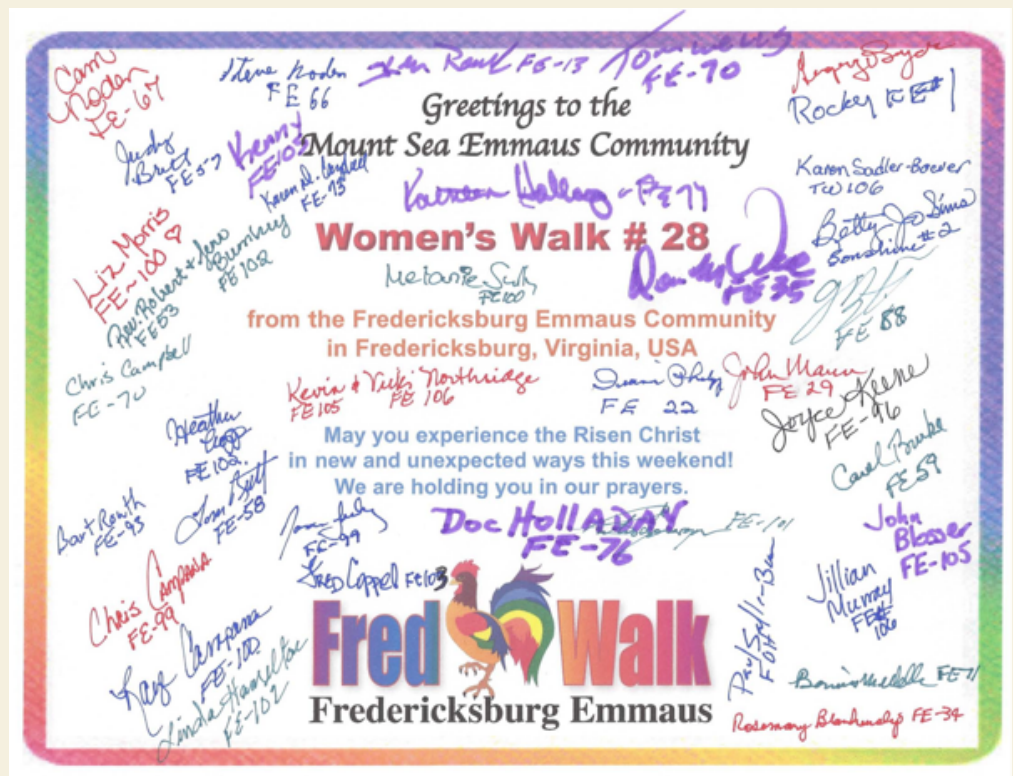

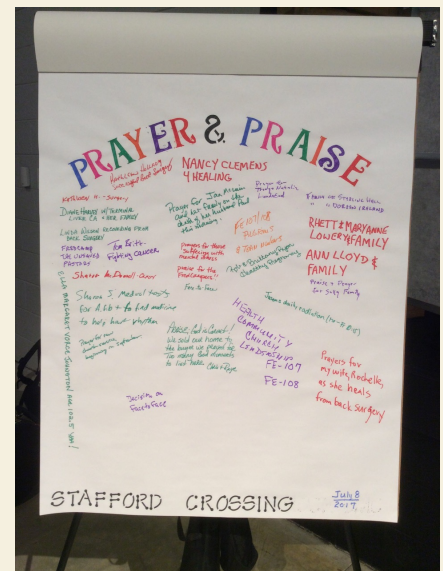

**Application Fee** \$25 – Due when you submit the completed application. If this fee is not included with the application the application will not be counted as valid until fee is received.

**Sponsorship Fee** \$200 – Due, (not mailed, but in the Treasurer's hands), no later than one week before the Walk, but preferably earlier. It is not acceptable to bring the Sponsorship Fee on the night the Walk starts.

A check must be written to Camp Happyland the morning of the Walk and is deposited the next day.

Therefore, for Emmaus to be good stewards and to be in line with strong business practices, you must send your fees in a minimum of one week before the walk.

**Team Fee** - \$200 – Due, (not mailed, but in Treasurer's hands), no later than one week before the Walk, but preferably earlier. It is preferable that this is given to the Board Rep, for your Walk, during teaming.
